KIOCL Limited, formerly known as Kudremukh Iron and Ore Company Limited, is a government-owned iron ore producer with its head office in Bangalore. The students were provided with an insightful session by Mr. Shivaraju, Senior Manager, Training and Safety Department. He focused on business operations, production processes, and the product profile of the company. The students also had an interactive session with the resource persons before being taken on a plant visit. The visit was a great opportunity for the students to witness the real-life workings of a government-owned iron ore producer.

The second industry visited by the students was Gurucharan Industries, a manufacturer and exporter of plastic processing machinery and spare parts. Mr. Gurucharan, the owner of the industry, showed and explained the process of making tarpaulin and also demonstrated the manufacturing of single crew extrusion in the plant. This provided the students with an in-depth understanding of the manufacturing process involved in the production of plastic processing machinery. The visit was aimed at exposing the students to the practical industry work culture and bridging the gap between classroom teaching and the corporate environment. The students gained valuable insights into the industry's dynamic work environment and how theoretical knowledge is applied in real-world scenarios.
