FIRST YEAR PARENT MEET 2025 (ODD SEMESTER)-REPORT

The Basic Science Department of Vivekananda College of Engineering and Technology (VCET), Puttur, in association with the Parent Relation Cell (PRC), organized the First-Year B.E. Parents–Teachers Meeting for the odd semester on 25-11-2025, Tuesday. The programme, held at Sri Savarkar Sabhabhavana Seminar Hall in the Krishna Chethana Block, commenced at 11:00 a.m. after the registration of parents.

The event began with an invocation by first-year students, followed by a formal welcome by Prof. Thejaswini L. P., Assistant Professor, Basic Science.
